### TENT CAMPERS URGED TO MOVE INDOORS

The National Weather Service has issued a Red Flag Warning through Monday, August 24 at 5 p.m. The Santa Cruz County Emergency Operations Center is urging evacuees from the Lightning Complex Fire currently staying outdoors in tents to seek indoor shelter immediately.

The County and its partners have established more than 2,200 shelter and safe parking spaces, with approximately 50 percent occupancy at this time.
