The newly remodeled Live Oak Public Library opened to the public on January 17, 2006. In a project funded by the Santa Cruz County Redevelopment Agency, the branch was expanded from 5,967 to 13,500 square feet. It now includes an adult reading room, a young adult room, a storytime area, and a homework center. The new building features Craftsman-Style design, public art, and beautiful views of Corcoran Lagoon.

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
